368 Women and children sheltered at EVE, Inc.'s shelter.

7,062 Nights women and children spent at EVE, Inc.'s shelter. An increase of 25% over last year

1,691 Calls to EVE, Inc.'s for crisis intervention, information or referrals.

341 Women and children received individual counseling by EVE, Inc.'s Masters & Doctoral level counselors.

2,853 Hours of counseling were provided by EVE,'s Counselors.

3,887 Individuals who took part in community education by EVE, Inc.'s staff. Includes domestic violence and dating violence prevention presentations.

1,271 Transportation trips provided to work, counseling sessions and support groups.

1,975 New individuals who received services from the Ingham County Personal Protection Order Office, which is operated by EVE, Inc.'s staff and volunteers.

⌘ Shelter Temporary safe housing, meals and personal care items.

⌘ Advocacy Case management services for shelter residents and non-residents in the areas of medical, financial, employment, legal aid, housing and transportation needs.

⌘ Counseling Individual and family counseling and support groups for women and children.

⌘ Personal Protection Order Office Technical assistance and information on the process of filing a Personal Protection Order. Located in the Veteran's Memorial Courthouse.

⌘ Children's Services Parenting classes, children's support groups, children's activities. Prevention Education for youth between 12-18; parent workshops on talking to children about healthy and unhealthy relationships.

⌘ Community Education Presentations in the community on domestic and dating violence and EVE's services.

⌘ Domestic Violence Support Unit - Located in the Ingham county Sheriff's Office, Mason. Funded by Mason Area United Way and the Ingham County Bar Foundation.

Programs are available to shelter residents and non-residents. You do not need to live in Ingham County to receive services.
