

Position Title: Legal Advocacy Intern/Volunteer Supervised By: Legal Advocacy Coordinator

Brief Description of the Position:

The Legal Advocacy Intern/Volunteer works with the Legal Advocacy Supervisor to provide information, support, and technical assistance to individuals seeking Personal Protection Orders (PPO's) within Ingham County. The Legal Advocacy Intern/Volunteer will screen individuals to ensure they qualify for a PPO and provide appropriate referrals and provide technical assistance to individuals who are experiencing PPO violations.

Requirements for the Position:

- **X** Punctuality, flexibility, and ability to work with some degree of independence.
- **X** Knowledge of domestic violence/ and or crisis intervention is helpful.
- **&** Strong organizational skills.
- **X** Strong written and verbal communication skills.
- **Respect for diversity.**

Duties and Responsibilities:

- **X** Provide information, support and technical assistance to individuals seeking Personal Protection Orders (PPO) within Ingham County and individuals who are experiencing PPO violations.
- **X** Screen individuals to ensure that they qualify for a PPO and provide appropriate referrals.
- **X** Provide information about and support at hearings associated with the PPO process.
- **X** Provide appropriate referrals to EVE (End Violent Encounters), Friend of the Court, Legal Aid, Prosecutor's Office, police department and other community organizations.
- **X** Develop and maintain effective communication and positive relations with court personnel, attorneys, law enforcement and judges. Respond in a timely manner to requests for information and support.
- **X** Maintain consistent communication with the Legal Advocacy Coordinator.
- **X** Coordinate follow-ups on expiration, service and hearings of petitioners.
- **X** Participate in special projects and other activities, as they become available.
